Accoutrements Marking Tapes


Package consists of 3 tapes @ 30 yards each.

- 4 lines per inch for 1/4 inch markings
- 9 lines per inch for 1/8 inch markings
- 12 lines per inch for 1/12 inch markings

The tape provides a fixed measure for precision cutting, or regulating stitch length. Can be easily repositioned.

How to use Accoutrements Marking Tapes for cutting pearl purls:

- Unreel 5 inches of the tape and cut it.
- Stick on fabric surface.
- · Lay pearl purl next to tape.
- Count out the number of spaces on the tape and cut with metal thread scissors. For example for 3/8 inch cuts---count 3 spaces on the 9 line tape and then cut the pearl. Count out the next 3 spaces and cut again.



The purls will bounce as they are cut and the fabric helps control it.

It is recommended to cut more than just one piece for your work particularly if you are filling in an area with cut purls. Line the cut pieces up on the fabric for easy selection as you stitch them on.

This tape can also be used for making even couching stitches in gold work, or for any kind of couching, hemstitching buttonholes or any kind of stitching that requires regulated stitches. Simply lay the tape just above or below the area to follow the lines.
